Keycloak on GKE — production-faithful IaC deployment

GCP / Terraform / Helm / CI-CD

- Deployed Keycloak on GKE end-to-end: Terraform modules (GKE, networking, CloudSQL, IAM), Helm release management, and GitHub Actions CI/CD with Workload Identity Federation and manual approval gates.
- Designed a three-level rollback strategy (Helm / Terraform / DB schema) and Cloud Monitoring alerting tuned to be actionable rather than noisy; used cert-manager DNS-01 for TLS.
- Debugged non-trivial GCP provider behaviour (e.g. a service-networking connection blocking teardown, resolved at the state level).
